END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT

January 1, 2018

The software and materials provided by Sonata Systems, Inc. are licensed, not sold, and are available for use only under the terms described hereafter. Please read this agreement carefully. By downloading, installing, copying or otherwise using the software and materials, you agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of this agreement. GRANT OF LICENSE: Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, Sonata Systems, Inc.

grants you a non-exclusive and non-transferable Sonata Canary license only to:

1. Install and use for personal or internal business purposes one copy of the Software on a single computer;
2. Make a single copy of the Software solely for archival purposes on a storage device such as a network server;
3. A single Sonata Canary license for the Software does not allow you to share the Software or use it concurrently on different computers or for others (other than you) to access, install, download, copy or otherwise use the functionality of the Software.
